### MAPS OF MOTOR VEHICLE ALLOWANCE GEOGRAPHICAL BOUNDARIES (DIRECTIVE 13/97)

This circular provides two maps to be used as aids in determining geographical boundaries for the purpose of motor vehicle allowances under Ministerial Directive 13/97.

In Directive 13/97 "Motor Vehicle Allowances" three geographical boundaries are defined for the purpose of motor vehicle allowance. As provided in Directive 13/97:

*The location of an officers's headquarters will determine which Division will apply to the officer. When travelling through different divisions, the officer should continue to be paid the appropriate allowance prescribed for the Division in which the officer's headquarters is located.*

The Divisions shown in the two maps (attached) are the "Geographical Boundaries" defined in Directive 13/97:

**Division I:** *The metropolitan area of Brisbane and the area within a radius of 80 kilometres of the GPO.*

**Division II:** *All centres east or south of a line drawn from the coast south along the 149th meridian of east longitude to the 26th parallel of south latitude and then west along that parallel to the western border of the State excluding those centres in Division I.*

**Division III:** *All centres west or north of a line drawn from the coast south along the 149th meridian of east longitude to the 26th parallel of south latitude and then west along that parallel to the western border of the State.*

The (attached) two maps have not been gazetted as part of Directive 13/97 and are to be used as a guide only. Should any doubts arise over the application of the geographical boundaries to a particular town or locality, the actual definitions found in Directive 13/97 should be applied in preference to the attached maps.

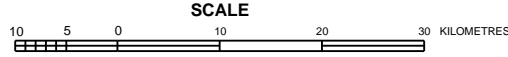

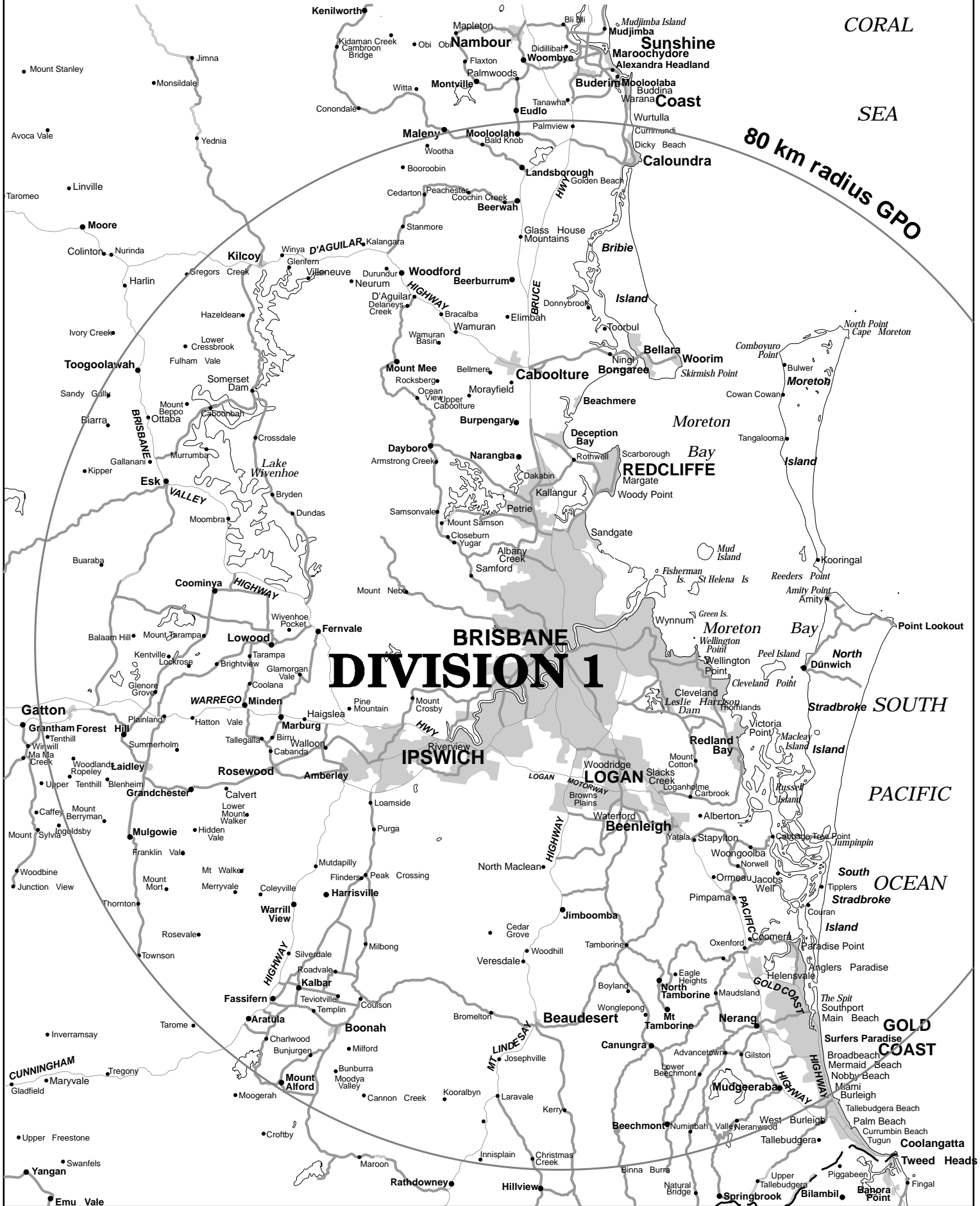

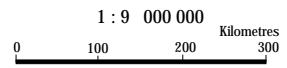
